Proof of Notice having been furnished, the Public Hearing on the 2017 Preliminary Budget was called to order at 6:00 pm by Supervisor Walter, who then led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The following person(s) spoke in favor of or against the preliminary budget:

- 1) Judge Allen stated that the amount for the Municipal Court Personal Services was not correctly stated in the paper, the amount should be \$13,200.
- 2) Mr. Neal Braley suggested an appropriation account be created for dead tree removal throughout the township. He then questioned the following accounts: A) Hwy Heating Fuel of \$16,000. Supervisor Walter stated that it was still lower than the amount two years ago, that the cost for fuel has gone down. B) Veteran Services of \$500. This goes towards flags for the graves every year. C) Program of the Aging of \$500. This is given towards the town residents who attend trips put on by the group. D) Cemetery Sales of \$2,000. Supervisor Walter stated that the town collected \$6,000 on 2015, and he estimates around \$2,000 for 2017. He also stated there are about 100 plots left and the town has a couple more years before having to deal with the NYS DEC.

Supervisor Walter then stated that the town would not to override the tax cap.

All person(s) desiring to be heard, having been heard, the Hearing was terminated at 6:26pm.
