Supervisor Walter called the meeting to order at 6:30pm. He introduced Barton & Loguidice representatives Mr. Dustin Clark and Mr. George Korkowski.

Mr. Clark began the presentation with a slide show and went over briefly the background data collected in the feasibility study. Also covered were potential water sources and the estimated costs per household.

Within the estimated cost part a small discussion was made regarding the percentage of EDU's and the cost per parcel.

Mr. Clark then went over estimated connection costs and showed a slide as follows:

- Water meter (5/8") = \$160
- PRV (3/4") = \$60 – if necessary
- Service lateral = \$15 to \$25 per foot
- Meter pit = \$600 – if necessary

Typical connection costs for a house lateral would be in the range of \$800 - \$2,000.

Steps to proceed were then gone over.

The floor was then opened for questions & answering: The main concern from the audience was that Albion is a poor town and many residents are on a fixed income and cannot afford more taxes/payments.

Supervisor Walter called the meeting to a close at 7:57pm.
